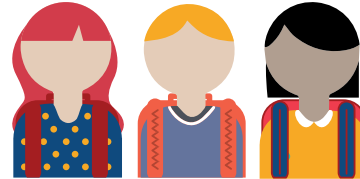

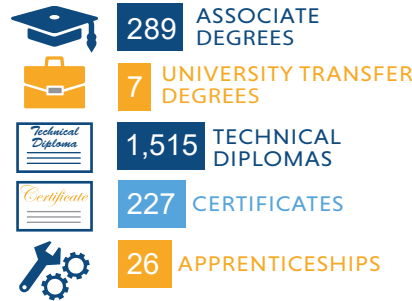
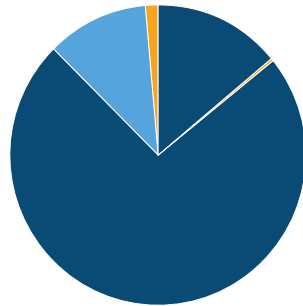
MEASURING STUDENT SUCCESS

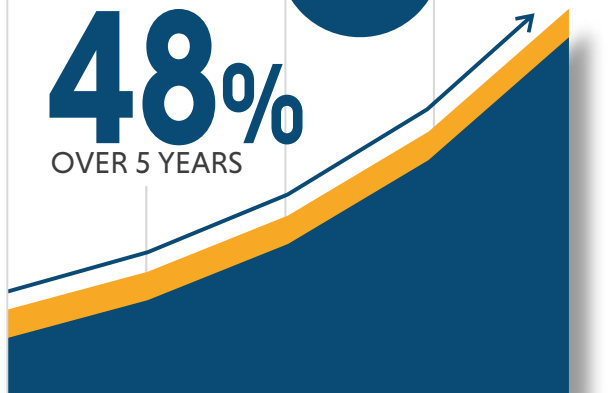

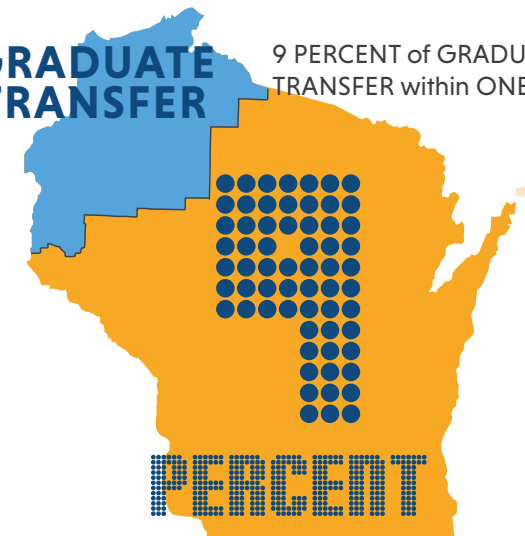
