➤ INNOVATIVE TEACHING & LEARNING CENTER (iTLC)

Academic Support Center: The Academic Support Center (ASC) supports you as you work to maximize your full academic potential. The ASC collaborates with faculty, staff, and other campus partners to provide a range of services, programs, and resources to support your learning. Support is student-centered, accessible, inclusive, and free of charge.

Math, Science, and Writing Labs: The Math, Science, and Writing Labs provide an opportunity to work with teaching specialists on a virtual drop-in basis. When attending the labs, please have your assignments, homework, and questions ready. The Math, Science, and Writing Labs are available to all students.

Academic Coach: Academic Coaching is available for students to learn more about managing time, learning styles and strategies, study skills or strategies, accountability, test-taking strategies, test-taking anxiety, note taking strategies, and more. Academic Coaching is free and available for all students by recommendation.

Learning Technology Center: Learning Technology Center (LTC) staff are available to provide hands-on and virtual support. You will have access to a computer lab that has all the software necessary to be a successful student at Northwood Tech, as well as printers, copiers, and scanners.

Library: Classroom Support Technicians are onsite to help you find the information you are looking for and help you bring that information into your work. Stop into the Library for access to computers, printers, scanners, books, journals and newspapers.
